The San Diego Queens Tournament is open to all women in the SDUSBC who meet the following eligibility requirements.

Contestants must have bowled a minimum of 48 games in San Diego in the current season. Original membership must be thru SDUSBC.

1. Contestants of the Queens Tournament may not practice on any of the tournament lanes prior to the tournament starting.
2. Bowlers will be allowed five (5) minutes of practice on their starting lanes.
3. This tournament will allow one (1) lane courtesy only.
4. Rule 319 1-5 will be waived.
5. Pinfall from six game qualifying round will not carry over to the semi-final round. High qualifier to receive award.
6. The tournament champion will receive a paid entry** into the **CAUSBC STATE QUEEN'S TOURNAMENT**. (\$125.00)
**NOTE: Should the Winner NOT choose to bowl in the State Queens, the runners up will be asked to bowl in the order that they finished.
7. Any entrant while participating in a scheduled event may be disqualified for any of the following reasons:
 - (a) Any infraction of rules.
 - (b) Conduct derogatory to the best interest of the tournament
 - (c) Use of foreign substance which comes in contact with the approach of the lanes.
8. Disqualification of entrant shall result in forfeiture of entry fee and any right to prize money.
9. Optional Side Pots.

Playing Format

1. Qualifying round: Each bowler will bowl six (6) games across twelve (12) lanes. Lane assignment will be determined by a draw of the tournament committee.
2. Semi-Finals: Nine (9) bowlers will advance to Semi-Finals (based on 20 entries). Each bowler will bowl three (3) additional games across six (6) lanes.
 - a. In the event of a tie for the last semi-finalist position, one (1) complete game will be bowled immediately. If a tie still exists at the end of the game, a ninth (9th) & tenth (10th) frame will be bowled until the tie is broken. The extra frames will start on the same lane each contestant finished on. Contestant on the odd numbered lane will start first. **This rule shall apply throughout the tournament whenever applicable.**
3. The top five (5) will bowl a stepladder format to determine the winner. In the event of a tie in any stepladder position, only a 9th and 10th frame will be bowled until the tie is broken.
4. Any contestant not present at official starting time will be disqualified.
