Qualifying: Sunday May 15th @ 10AM

Check in one hour prior to squad time (9:00 AM)

(NOTE: Currently active PBA and PWBA members not eligible for tournament)

The San Diego Queens (Women) & Masters (Men) Tournament is open to all Bowlers in the SDUSBC. Multi-Members must have purchased a Multi-member Card (USBC Rule 101) and be currently bowling in a league in the San Diego Assoc. With 21 games or more as of May 14th, 2016. (No cards will be sold on site.)

1. Contestants of the Queens and Masters Tournament may not practice on any of the tournament lanes prior To tournament starting.
2. Bowlers will be allowed ten (10) minutes practice on their starting lanes.
3. USBC Rule 319d will be waved.
4. The tournament champions will receive a paid entry into the 2017 SDUSBC Queens/Masters Tournament
5. Any entrant while participating, may be disqualified for any of the following reasons:
 - a. Any infraction of the rules.
 - b. Conduct derogatory to the best interest of the Tournament.
 - c. Use of foreign substance which comes in contact with the approach or lanes.
6. *Disqualification of entrant/no show* will result in forfeiture of the entry fee and any right to prize money.
7. Optional brackets.
8. Bowlers are responsible to be present at the beginning of the tournament. Should a bowler arrive after the official starting time, they will receive a **zero for each frame missed.**

PRIZE FUND BREAKDOWN will be determined on the number of entries.

Queens*

Qualifying Round:

Each bowler will bowl five (5) games across the required number of lanes, moving 1 pair to the right after each game. Lane assignments will be drawn by contestants. There will be a 30 minute break.

Finals:

Top 6 bowlers will then bowl match play, the final round being a position round. Winner of each round shall be awarded 30 bonus points. The highest pin fall with awarded points is the 2016 Queens Champion.

After each match, bowlers will move to a different set of lanes.

Masters*

Qualifying Round:

Each bowler will bowl six (6) games across the required number of lanes, moving 1 pair to the right after each game. Lane assignments will be drawn by the contestants. There will be a 30 minute break.

Finals:

Top 8 bowlers will then bowl match play, the final round being a position round. Winner of each round shall be awarded 30 bonus points. The highest pin fall with awarded points is the 2016 Masters Champion.

After each match, bowlers will move to a different set of lanes.

* In the event of a tie for the last qualifying position, a ninth (9th) and tenth (10th) frame will be bowled until the tie is broken. The extra frames will start on the same lane each contestant finished on. Contestant on the odd numbered lane will start first. This rule shall apply throughout the tournament whenever applicable.

***Dress Code**

Collared, Mock Collared, Collarless t-shirt/sports type, dress shirts. Long pants or knee length walking shorts are permissible. Offensive attire, tank tops, or hats **NOT** permitted. Any dress code questions or concerns will be addressed by the Chairman of the committee. Any questions not herein covered will be decided by the Tournament Committee

EQUIPMENT:

The Tournament Manager will handle any Questionable circumstances.

Equipment Alterations:

Altering the surface of a bowling ball by the use of abrasives, cleaners or polish is prohibited during competition, in addition, no substance may be placed on the outer surface of the bowling ball. You are permitted to sand the surface of your bowling balls prior to certified competition, however, the use of abrasives is strictly prohibited once the first ball is thrown in competition. The outer surface of the bowling ball may only be cleaned with a dry towel once the bowler has begun competition. No modifications can be made to affect the balance of the bowling ball once competition has begun.

Competition is defined as any time individuals are bowling for score.

Penalty for the first offense...individual is warned and the ball is removed from that competition for the remainder of the series, match. Second offense...Disqualification from the remainder of the event in which the violation occurred.
