San Diego USBC Open & Women City Championships Tournament Rules

ELIGIBILITY: Current Members of the SD USBC Bowling Assoc. are eligible to participate in this tournament. Membership cards must be shown.

Multi-Members must have purchased a Multi-Member Card (USBC Rule 101) and be currently bowling in a league in the San Diego Assoc. with 21 games or more as of March 18th, 2016. (No Cards will be sold on site.)

ENTRY FEE: \$24.50 per event. Team / Doubles / Singles + \$6.50 for All Events for a total of \$80.00 per bowler.

Trophy & Expense Fee \$2.00 per event. (Except All Events)

CLOSING DATE: March 18th, 2016

ENTERING AVERAGE RULES:

- Entering average shall be your highest 2014-2015 average of 21 games or more summer or winter which ever is highest. If no 2014-2015 average use
- Highest current average as of March 20th, 2016 with league sheet for verification.
- If none of the above the entering average will be 230.
- USBC Rule 319a-3 will apply. Rule 319 D waived for this tournament.
 Average Re-Rate and adjustment: If you bowl in a standard (not a Sport/Challenge Condition) league and have 21 games or more you will use your standard average. If you ONLY have a Sport/Challenge Condition average of 21 games of more you will use the sport average. The Sport/challenge Condition average will be subject to receive the sport average.

The Sport/challenge Condition average will be subject to re-rate.

If bowler does not accept the re-rated average, the entry fee will be refunded.

NOTE: Any returned check will cost \$35.00 service charge + bank charges.

CHECK IN TIME: TEAM, SINGLES & DOUBLES will check in one hour before scheduled time to bowl.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND RULES: - No bowler may change the position in any lineup after the entry has been accepted and scheduled by the Tournament Manager.

- (1) Entrants may participate three(3) times in the team event, however no more than 2 bowlers on one team can place more than once in the prize list for position standings. (See USBC Rule 315 B-1). Bowlers may participate ONLY ONCE IN THE DOUBLES AND SINGLES EVENTS.
- (2) When a bowler is a member of more than one team, (maximum of three) the FIRST SCORE bowled in team event shall count for the ALL-EVENTS.
- (3) No team or individual shall be entitled to a refund after the fees have been received, and a schedule date has been assigned.
- (4) In the event a bowler is late, the team receives zero for the frames missed, bowler may enter the frame currently being bowled. If a bowler cannot continue due to an injury and no replacement is available, the team receives zero for that bowler.
- (5) The Tournament Manager may refuse any team or individual to bowl if it is determined that the entry does not meet the membership and tournament requirements.
- (6) Only two (2) Pro-Bowlers per team, one per doubles.
- (7) HANDICAP: 90% OF 230 SCRATCH.

Practice will not be allowed on your scheduled lanes on the day of the tournament.

SUBSTITUTIONS: - will be allowed in each event. (Team -Doubles & Singles). There will be no changes in the original line-up. If a substitute is used, they will bowl in the position of the bowler being replaced.

Any monetary arrangements should be made in writing with the original entrant, substitute and the tournament chairman before the event(s) are bowled. Substitutions can be made at the SDUSBC office prior to the closing date of entries, or at the tournament site one (1) hour prior to the scheduled event. NO PACERS ALLOWED.

PROTESTS: USBC Rule 329 Any protest affecting eligibility or general rules MUST be submitted in writing to the Association Manager before the prize payments are made. The board of directors shall have the power to act on all protests. The tournament committee will decide on all matters pertaining to the tournament. Appeals from the Tournament Committee decision must be filed in writing to the National USBC, Arlington, TX prior to the payment of prizes. The decision of the United States Bowling Congress is final and binding.

SCHEDULING: Tournament Manager will schedule teams at the times requested if those times are available. If necessary due to lack of entries or too few requests for any scheduled time, teams may be changed to a different squad. Captain will be notified of any change.

ALL EVENTS: Participation in the All Events is <u>OPTIONAL</u> must be paid before closing date. The \$6.50 entry fee will be returned 100% in a ratio of one (1) prize for every (15) entries. There will be a ratio of (1) prize for every (7) entries paid in the Team, Singles & Doubles Events. All prize money returned 100%.

AWARDS: Team(4) Doubles(2) Singles(1) All Events(1) (Total 16 Awards, Open & Women).

EQUIPMENT:

The Tournament Manager will handle any questionable circumstances.

Equipment Alterations:

Attering the surface of a bowling ball by the use of abrasives, cleaners or polish is prohibited during competition, in addition, no substance may be placed on the outer surface of the bowling ball. You are permitted to sand the surface of your bowling balls prior to certified competition, however, the use of abrasives is strictly prohibited once the first ball is thrown in competition. The outer surface of the bowling ball may only be cleaned with a dry towel once the bowler had begun competition. No modifications can be made to affect the balance of the bowling ball once competition has begun. (i.e. Additional weight holes, modification of existing holes, etc).

NOTE:

Rule 18/3 - Since the tournament is conducting doubles and singles concurrently, you cannot alter the surface of the bowling ball (including sanding) between events.

Competition is defined as any time teams of individuals are bowling for score.

- Penalty for the first offense...individual is warned and the ball is removed from that competition for the remainder of the series, match or block. (Doubles and Singles is considered a block)
- Second offense...Disqualification from the remainder of the event in which the violation occurred.

FOREIGN SUBSTANCE

Also, no foreign substances can be applied to bowling shoes or approaches. This includes, but is not limited to: rosin, powder, Easy-Slide, dry bags, slide stone, soap stone, polish wax, alcohol and like products.

- Penalty for the first offense: Individual is warned.
- Second offense: Disqualification from the remainder of the event; in which violation occurred.

Oress Code

Entrants are expected to wear suitable attire. Use good judgment when selecting the appropriate attire.

Examples of unacceptable attire include but are not limited to: • Hats • Tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops, etc
• Workout attire, short shorts, short skirts, bib overalls, jeans that are not neat, clean or in good condition (no torn jeans)

Bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by tournament management. Tournament management's decision will be final.

Opening Ceremonies will be at Parkway Bowl on Saturday, April 2nd at 11:45 AM
