Adult Men and Women - Regular & Senior Divisions
2022- 2023 All Star Team Requirements

A) Eligibility Requirements:

1. You shall be a member in good standing of the SDUSBC.
2. Purchase your original certified card through the SDUSBC.
3. Only events certified, sponsored or conducted by the SDUSBC will be eligible for points.
4. Selections will be made on the basis of overall performance, sportsmanship and character.
5. Must file an All-Star application by delivering to the association office or postmarked no later than November 15, 2022 to be eligible for the current season.
 - League names and bowling centers must be designated clearly in the application.
 - The bowler is responsible to verify All-Star application is on file at association office.
 - May also be given to an SDUSBC Board Member.
6. **Must select two sanctioned leagues in two separate centers or 2 leagues in the same center** under SDUSBC jurisdiction in the current bowling year starting September 1, 2022 through May 15, 2023 or the completion of the league whichever occurs first. League with multiple short sessions will be allowed.
7. Must have bowled 50 or more games in each league designated on the application.
8. A bowler shall be 55 as of August 1st, 2022 to be considered a Senior .

B) Method of turning in scores:

1. The All-Star committee will compile all applicants' scores for bowling year September 1, 2022 thru May 15, 2023 or the end of winter league. The Committee will accept the following:
 - League Secretary.com print-outs, to be turned in by bowler or collected by committee.
 - Bowling center computer print-outs of designated leagues, to be turned in by bowler or collected by committee.
 - **No faxed documents will be acceptable.**

 - * NOTE: If the submitted total points qualify you for both the regular division and/or senior categories (age 55 no later than Aug 1 ** of the selection year), which would you prefer.
 - Senior _____ or Regular _____.

C. Criteria for accumulating All-Star points:

1. Composite league average of designated leagues on application.
2. Only first three (3) game series shall count regardless of the total number of games bowled in a league or certified tournament.
3. Scores from singles league do not qualify. Sport league will NOT be rerated for all star points.
4. A minimum of 600 points for men and 400 points for women shall be accumulated in order to be considered for the teams.
5. Maximum of one 300 game and one 800 series from a non-designated league or SDUSBC sanctioned tournament will count.

D. METHOD OF ACCUMULATING POINTS:

1. Composite League Average - 1 point per pin

Note: Composite average—both league averages added together and divided by 2.

End of league or May 15th average from league sheet. Sport league averages will be adjusted USBC conversion chart. Bowlers using 2 centers will receive 20 bonus points.
