



SAN DIEGO USBC BOWLING ASSOCIATION
Adult Men and Women Regular & Senior Divisions
2017 - 2018 All Star Team Requirements

A) Eligibility Requirements:

1. Be a member in good standing of the San Diego USBC.
2. Purchase your original membership card through the San Diego USBC.
3. Only leagues or events certified, sponsored, or conducted by the San Diego USBC shall be eligible for points.
4. Selections shall be made on the basis of overall performance, sportsmanship, and character.
5. Must file an All-Star Application with the association office or postmarked no later than November 15, 2017 to be eligible for the current season.
 - League names and bowling centers must be designated clearly on the application.
 - The bowler is responsible to verify All-Star Application accuracy and is on file at association office.
6. **Must select two sanctioned leagues** in two separate bowling centers under San Diego USBC jurisdiction in Current bowling year starting August/September 2017 thru May 31, 2018, or completion of league whichever occurs first.
7. Must have bowled 60 or more games in each league designated on the application. Split designated leagues that starts in August/September of current bowling year are combined.
8. A bowler shall be 50 years of age as of August 1, 2017 to be considered a Senior.
9. If "grand total" of points qualifies you for both, regular and senior division, the regular division team placement shall take precedence.

B) Disqualification:

1. Any bowler who exhibits poor sportsmanship during any San Diego USBC bowling event, observed by any association board member, or is reported to San Diego USBC, shall be subject to disqualification.
2. Any bowler who submits a "bad check" (NSF) through San Diego USBC, shall be subject to disqualification.

C) Method of turning in scores:

1. Any All-Star Committee or Association Board member may accept all applicants' scores for current bowling year.
 - Accepting Committee/Board member is expected to write the date and clearly sign your name on the document received before submission to association office or committee chairman.
 - The applicant shall submit originals or copies of each recap sheet containing highlighted eligible scores from designated leagues on application.
 - It is requested that scores be turned in each 4 – 6 weeks. **"No faxed documents will be accepted"**.
2. League Secretary.com or Bowling Center computer print-outs shall be submitted each 4 – 6 weeks by bowler.
 - Recap of scores may be given to any Committee/Board member, delivered to association office or emailed as an attachment to usbclynn@yahoo.com
 - It is the Bowlers responsibility to verify all scores for consideration have been received by SDUSBC association office or committee chairman, checked for accuracy, and completeness of said submissions by Midnight May 31, 2018.
 - Only San Diego USBC honor scores are eligible for All-Star points from non-designated SDUSBC Certified Winter, Certified Summer leagues & Certified Tournaments. It is the bowler's responsibility to verify submittal of this information via original/copy of recap sheet, copy of League Secretary print-out or copy of bowling center computer print-out to the association office by Midnight May 31, 2018.

D) Criteria for accumulating All-Star points:

1. Average of leagues designated on application.
 - Add both final May 31, 2018 averages together, divide by 2. (1 point per pin)
2. Only first three (3) games for series shall count regardless of the total number of games bowled in league or certified tournament.
 - San Diego USBC honor scores for additional games will be recognized.
3. Scores from singles leagues do not qualify.
4. Sport or Challenge League Averages shall NOT be rerated for All Star Points.
5. A minimum of 275 points must be accumulated in order to be considered for All Star Team.
6. Any 298-299-300 game bowled by a Man or Woman, or 800 series for Men, or 725 for Women, shall be considered San Diego USBC honor scores.
