Combined Men and Women - Regular & Senior Divisions

2011/2012 All Star Team Requirements

A) Eligibility Requirements:

1. Be a member in good standing of the SD/USBC.
2. Purchase your original membership card through the SD/USBC. (See 6 & 7 below)
3. Only events certified, sponsored or conducted by the SD/USBC will be eligible for points.
4. Selections will be made on the basis of overall performance, sportsmanship and character.
5. Must file an All-Star application by delivering to the association office or postmarked no later than October 31, 2011 to be eligible for the current season.
 - League names and bowling centers must be designated clearly on the application.
 - The bowler is responsible to verify All-Star application is on file at association office.
 - May also be given to an SDUSBC Board Member.
6. Must have bowled in two sanctioned leagues under SD/USBC in two separate bowling centers under SD/USBC jurisdiction in the current bowling year starting September 1, 2011 through May 15, 2012.
7. Must have bowled 60 or more games in each league designated on the application.
8. A bowler shall be 50 as of Aug 1st ** of current year to be considered a Senior *.
9. Any bowler who submits a **bad check** through the Local USBC shall be subject to disqualification

B) Method of turning in scores:

1. The All-Star committee will accept all applicants' scores for bowling year September 1, 2011 thru May 15, 2012. The Committee will accept the following:
 - The applicant shall submit original's or copies of every recap sheet containing **highlighted** eligible scores from designated leagues on application. **It is requested that scores be turned in on a monthly basis.**
 - League Secretary.com print-outs, to be turned in **monthly** by bowler. Scores may be given to any committee member. Eligible scores need to be **highlighted**. The Local Association will NOT be searching for scores for the applicants. It is the Bowlers responsibility to turn in all scores for consideration.
 - Bowling center computer print-outs of designated leagues, to be turned in by bowler **(Monthly)**.
 - Only honor scores will be eligible for All-Star points from non-designated leagues or certified tournament play and is the bowler's responsibility to submit this information via original/copy of recap sheet to the association office by May 15, 2012.
 - **No faxed documents will be acceptable.**
 - Any 298-299-300 game or 800 series (700 Women) and 11 in a row, bowled in Summer leagues conducted, sponsored, or certified through the SD/USBC will be credited the following year .
 - * NOTE: If the submitted total points qualify you for both the regular and/or senior categories (age 50 no later than Aug 1 ** of the selection year), the highest point total earned will take precedence.

C. Criteria for accumulating All-Star points:

1. Composite league average of designated leagues on application.
2. Only first three (3) game series shall count regardless of the total number of games bowled in a league or certified tournament.
 - a. Honor scores for additional games will be recognized.
3. Scores from singles leagues do not qualify. (Sport League Averages will NOT be related for All Star Points.)
4. A minimum of 275 points shall be accumulated in order to be considered for the teams.

D. Method of accumulating points:

1. Composite League Average - 1 point per pin

Note: Composite average—both league averages added together and divided by 2.

Must not be from the same bowling center (April 15th averages)

Averages from summer leagues are not eligible. (Honor scores will be accepted)

2. Point Structure

- a. Tournaments

Masters, Senior Masters, Queens, and City Tournament

First Place	15 Points
Runner up	11 Points
Third Place	8 Points
Fourth Place	7 Points
Fifth Place	6 Points

Note: Scores from tournaments (Other than Honor Scores) will not be considered for points.
