# San Diego USBC Youth City Championships

## Tournament Rules

### Eligibility:

- 1) Open to all current 2024/2025 league certified bowlers in San Diego USBC bowling association jurisdiction with minimum of 12 games as of January 1, 2025 with League Sheet Verification. (no Membership Cards sold on site)
- 2) Multi-Members shall be currently bowling in a 2024/2025 certified league under SDUSBC jurisdiction with minimum of 12 games as of January 1, 2025, with League Sheet Verification. (no Membership cards sold on site)

### Entering Average:

- 1) Shall be highest sanctioned 2023/2024 winter book average of at least 12 games or more. If none,
- 2) Current average of 12 games or more as of December 15, 2024, with League Sheet Verification. If none,
- 3) Average will be assigned by committee.
- 4) If you bowl in Certified Standard Leagues, the highest average shall be used. If you only have a Certified Sport/Challenge condition league average of 12 games or more, this average shall be adjusted according to USBC Conversion Chart. If the bowler does not accept adjusted average, the entry fee shall be refunded.

### Divisions:

1. Division I – 160 and over, Division II – 130 to 159, Division III - 129 and under.
2. Team average will be Division I – 640 and over, Division II – 520 to 639, Division III – 519 and under. Doubles: Division I – 320 and over, Division II – 250 to 319, and Division III – 249 and under. Singles: see line 1

### General Information & Rules:

- 1) Any NSF returned checks will cost \$35.00 plus any additional bank charges.
- 2) Bowlers shall not be entitled to a refund after fees have been received and lane assignments are issued by association. Exceptions shall be determined by Tournament Manager.
- 3) The Tournament Manager may refuse any team or individual to bowl if determined the entry does not meet membership or tournament requirements.
- 4) In the event a bowler is tardy, may still participate starting in the frame currently being bowled, however shall receive “zero” score for each frame missed.
- 5) If a bowler cannot continue tournament play due to an injury/illness & no replacement is available, the team receives “zero” for that bowler.
- 6) Line-up changes shall not be permitted once entry has been submitted, squad times, and lanes have been assigned by Tournament Mgr.
- 7) Entrants may participate multiple times in team event. In order to place more than once in the prize list for positions standings, at least two (2) players in the lineup must be different. (see USBC rule 315B-1). **MAY PARTICIPATE ONLY ONCE IN DOUBLES & SINGLES.**
- 8) When a bowler is a member of more than 1 team, the **FIRST SERIES** bowled shall be used for All Events.
- 9) Handicap is based on 90% of 220.
- 10) No practice is permitted on your scheduled lanes the day of tournament.
- 11) **Substitutions:** Are permitted in each event (team/doubles/singles) and shall bowl in same position as same person as being replaced.
- 12) **NO PACERS ALLOWED**
- 14) **Scheduling:** Tournament Manager shall schedule squad times requested on entry if possible. If necessary, due to lack of entries or too few requests for specific squad time, may be changed to different squad/day and team captain shall be notified.
- 15) **Awards:** First place award in each division only. Prize Funds: Shall be 100% returned and distributed as follows; Team/Doubles/Singles (1) for every (7) entries, All Events (1) for every (10) for each division. All Events prize money from SDUSBC unassigned SMART fund. SMART scholarships will be paid for each division and all events.
- 16) Absolutely no **UNSOLICITED** coaching will be allowed during the tournament by either coaches or parents. No one other than tournament officials and score monitors will be permitted in the bowlers area. Anyone (other than tournament participants) entering the youth bowling area **MUST** be RVP certified and wearing their badge.
- 17) Bowlers shall remain on same pair of lanes for both Doubles & Singles events.
- 18) Playing of any arcade games or use of any electronic equipment from the first ball of practice until the completion of bowling are cause for disqualification. **Penalty:** First offence, bowler is warned. Second offence is disqualification from that particular event.
- 19) **Equipment:** Altering the surface of bowling balls, using abrasives, cleaner, or polish is prohibited once competition has started. The outer surface may only be cleaned with dry towel. Also, no modifications allowed that may affect bowling ball balance, such as weight, or existing finger/thumb holes also prohibits equipment modification between Doubles and Singles events. No balance holes allowed, must use all holes for gripping. (See Rules, Chapter 8)  
**Penalty:** First offence, bowler is warned, and ball removed from that particular event. Second offence is disqualification from that particular event.
- 20) **Approach Foreign Substance:** No foreign substance is permitted to be applied to bowling shoes or approaches. This includes, but not limited to; powder, rosin, easy slide, soap/slide stone, polish wax, and like products. Any questions/concerns contact Tournament Manager.  
**Penalty:** First offence, bowler is warned. Second offence is disqualification from that particular event.

**Protests: USBC Rule 329:** Any protests affecting eligibility or general rules **MUST** be submitted in writing to the Association Manager before awards and prize payments are made. The board of directors shall have the power to act on all protests. The Tournament Committee shall have authority to act on all matters pertaining to the tournament. Appeals from the Tournament Committee shall be filed in writing to National USBC in Arlington, Texas, also prior to awards & prize moneys are distributed. The decision of National USBC is final & binding.

### Dress Code:

Collared, sports type t-shirt, long pants, clean jeans (no holes), walking shorts, skorts, and skirts are permitted. **UNACCEPTABLE ATTIRE:** hats, tank/halter/spaghetti string tops, bib overalls, short-shorts, leggings, baggy sweatpants. Any dress code questions/concerns shall be addressed by the Chairperson of the committee. Tournament Manager's decision is final.
