## SAN DIEGO USBC SENIOR MEN'S MASTERS AMATUER TOURNAMENT GENERAL PLAYING RULES

1. Open to all senior men ( 55 and over) as of the tournament date with a valid SAN DIEGO USBC Association sanction card and bowling in a league with 21 games or more. Any bowler who is currently and/ or actively participating in a national professional tournament will be ineligible to participate in this tournament.
2. Entry fee - $\$ 75.00$; Mail in by Aug. $9^{\text {th }}$ or walk-in to Assoc Office by Aug $15^{\text {th }}$ no later than Noon. On-site $\$ 90.00$
3. If total number of entries are 25 or less, tournament will be conducted as a one(1) day format.
4. Check in time will be ONE HALF (1/2) HOUR prior to scheduled time of bowling.
5. Qualifying rounds will consist of six ( 6 ) games bowled across twelve (12) lanes moving one pair of lanes to your right after each game. Cut to be based on $1 / 3$ of total entries.
6. Tardy bowlers will receive a zero for any frames missed.
7. THERE WILL BE NO CARRY OVER OF PINS FROM THE QUALIFYING ROUNDS.
8. SEMI-FINALS will be based on a 3-game elimination format. Top qualifier will draw first for starting lane. Any ties for the Semi-Finals a one (1) game roll-off will be bowled.
Then if a tie still exists, a $10^{\text {th }}$ frame roll-off will be bowled until tie is broken.
9. Finals: step-ladder format. Any ties, a $10^{\text {th }}$ frame roll-off will be bowled to determine the winner of that match.
10. USBC rule 319d will be waived.
11. Tournament committee may do a random check of bowling equipment for compliance of USBC certification.
12. Dress Code: no shorts, hats, or tank tops will be allowed.
13. No Pay off at the tournament site, payoff will be within 30 days of the tournament.
14. Tournament Committee shall decide any and all disputes. Their decision is final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
