## SAN DIEGO USBC SENIOR MEN'S MASTERS AMATUER TOURNAMENT GENERAL PLAYING RULES

1. Open to all senior men ( $\mathbf{5 0}$ and over) as of the tournament date with a valid SAN DIEGO USBC Association sanction card and bowling in a league with 21 games or more. Any bowler who is currently and/ or actively participating in a national professional tournament will be ineligible to participate in this tournament.
2. Entry fee $-\mathbf{\$ 7 5 . 0 0}$; Mail in by Aug. ${ }^{\text {th }}$ or walk-in to Assoc Office by Aug $14^{\text {th }}$ no later than Noon. On-site $\$ 100.00$
3. Check in time will be ONE HALF (1/2) HOUR prior to scheduled time of bowling.
4. Qualifying rounds will consist of eight (8) scratch games bowled moving one pair of lanes to your right after each game.
5. Tardy bowlers will receive a zero for any frames missed.
6. THERE WILL BE NO CARRY OVER OF PINS TO THE FINAL ROUND.
7. Finals: Qualifiers bowl an elimination match with lowest score dropping after each match until a Champion has been determined as follows: Based on 25 entries, 4 will advance. If 30 entries 5 will advance. If 35 entries 6 will advance and dropping 2 after first elimination round. If 40 entries 7 will advance and dropping 3 after first elimination round. After each game move one(1) pair to the right. Any ties, a $10^{\text {th }}$ frame roll-off will be bowled to determine the winner of that match.
8. USBC rule 319d will be waived.
9. Dress Code: COLLARED SHIRTS AND LONG PANTS DISQUALIFACTION WILL BE ENFORCED. NO shorts, hats, or tank tops will be allowed.
10. No Pay off at the tournament site, payoff will be within 30 days of the tournament.
11. Tournament Committee shall decide any and all disputes. Their decision is final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
12. All bowling equipment subject to inspection by tournament official.
