## 2007 SAN DIEGO USBC SENIOR MENS MASTERS TOURNAMENT GENERAL PLAYING RULES

- 1. Open to all **senior men** (55 and over) as of the tournament date with a valid **SAN DIEGO USBC** Association sanction card.
- 2. Entry fee \$75.00\_; Mail in by Aug. 8<sup>th</sup> or walk-in to Assoc Office by Aug 10<sup>th</sup> no later than Noon. On-site \$90.00
- 3. Check in time will be ONE HALF (1/2) HOUR prior to scheduled time of bowling.
- 4. BOWLERS WILL DRAW FOR STARTING LANE.
- **5.** Qualifying rounds will consist of six (6) games bowled across twelve (12) lanes moving one pair of lanes to your right after each game.
- 6. Tardy bowlers will receive a zero for any frames missed during the qualifying rounds.
- 7. THERE WILL BE NO CARRY OVER OF PINS FROM THE QUALIFYING ROUNDS.
- 8. The 16 bowlers to qualify for semi-finals is based on total pins for 6 games.
- 9. The top non-qualifier from the qualifying round will be 1st alternate for semi-finals.
- 10.**SEMI-FINALS** will be based on a <u>2-game elimination format</u>. Top qualifier will draw first for starting lane. Any ties for the top 8 Finalists, a 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll-off will be bowled.
- 11. **Finals**: will be based on a <u>single game elimination format.</u> Any ties, a 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll-off will be bowled to determine the winner of that match.
- 12. The requirement of USBC rule 319d will be waived.
- 13. If a bowler who qualified for the finals is unable to bowl, the first alternate shall take his place in the schedule. If alternate is not available for the finals, his opponent will bowl unopposed and be declared the winner of that match. Any prize monies earned will be divided equally between the bowler and his replacement.
- 14. Tournament committee may do a random check of bowling equipment for compliance of USBC certification.
- 15. **Dress Code**: no shorts, hats, or tank tops will be allowed.
- 16. No Pay off at the tournament site, payoff will be within 30 days of the tournament.
- 17. Tournament Committee shall decide any and all disputes. Their decision is final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
