SENIOR BOWLER OF THE YEAR  
EVALUATION CRITERIA

1. Must be a member in good standing of the San Diego USBC Bowling Association, Participated in the Annual Senior Men's Masters, **OR** City Championship Tournaments.
2. Must have reached their 55th Birthday no later than August 1st of the selection year.
3. Selections will be made on the basis of **Performance, Sportsmanship and Character.**
4. Must bowl a **minimum of 60 games in one Travel league, OR two leagues in separate bowling centers, (minimum three member teams)** in the jurisdiction of the San Diego USBC Bowling Association in the current year.  
**Bowler must designate the two leagues that points will be recorded from by Jan 1, 2006 to receive credit.**

**METHOD OF ACCUMLATING POINTS:**

**POINTS**

**CERTIFIED LEAGUES**

Highest League Average (60 or more games)	1 point per pin
Second Highest League Average - if any (60 or more games)	1/10 point per pin
Must not be from the same bowling center (as of April 15) (Averages from summer leagues are not eligible).	

**CITY HANDICAP TOURNAMENT**

Member of Team Champions	2 points each	<b>5 Bonus points each event</b> Bowl in SD/City Tournament or Bowl in SD/Masters or Bowl in SD/Senior Masters Attend USBC open meeting

To receive credit for the current season: **ALL SCORES** and information must be into the SD/USBC Office By **JUNE 1, 2006** **IT IS THE BOWLERS responsibility** that they be submitted on time.

\* **NOTE:** If the submitted total points qualify you for **BOTH** the senior category (age 55 no later than Aug 1<sup>st</sup> of the selection year), **AND** the regular Division (under age 55 no later than Aug 1<sup>st</sup> of the selection year), the highest point total under the criteria earned will take precedence.

**All Star Requirements**

**Men: Regular & Senior Division**

Qualify for **MALE BOWLER OF THE YEAR** and become a member of the **MEN'S ALL STAR TEAM!**

The eligibility requirements are:

- A. You must be a member in **Good Standing** of the San Diego USBC. Purchase your original certified card through the SD/USBC, and reside in the San Diego area.
- B. Only events Certified, sponsored or conducted by the SD/USBC will be eligible for points.
- C. Selections will be made on the basis of Performance, Sportsmanship and Character.
- D. Criteria for Points:
  1. Must have bowled in **at least** one sanctioned travel league (schedule must be Provided with application) **OR** two sanctioned leagues **in separate bowling Centers** under SD/USBC jurisdiction in the current year starting September 1<sup>st</sup> Through May 15th. **Scores from singles or doubles leagues do not qualify.**
  2. Composite league average of the designated leagues or travel league:
    - a. One (1) point per pin of 60 or more games
    - b. Must **not** be in the same center
    - c. Only the first three (3) game series shall count, but High Game scores will be Recognized regardless of the total number of games bowled in a league or Certified Tournament.
  3. **All Star applications** must be submitted or postmarked **no later** than January 1, 2007 to be eligible for the current season.
  4. Leagues and centers **must be designated and reported, in writing,** to the SD/USBC office no later than January 1, 2007. Participant is **responsible** for Verifying that his All Star application is on file. Once the application is received, it shall Remain in effect for the entire season.
  5. It is **your responsibility** to submit to the SD/USBC office:
    - a. **All honor scores WITHIN 31 DAYS** from the date bowled, including: **750 plus series and/or 275 plus games** in a non-designated center/league. (See reverse side for Point Criteria)
    - b. **Scores received AFTER 31 DAYS** will not be considered.
    - c. May 1<sup>st</sup> through May 15th scores **MUST** be in the SD/USBC office by May 31<sup>st</sup>.  
**Any 298-300 Game or 800 Series bowled AFTER** May 15<sup>th</sup> in events conducted, Sponsored, or certified through the SD/USBC will be awarded points. These Points will be credited to the following year.
    - d. It is the bowler's responsibility to provide a signed original or a copy of the recap sheets making sure that your name and scores are circled, highlighted and legible. **(One sheet for multiple competitors will not be accepted.)**  
**Fax submissions are not accepted.** All submissions must be received by the SD/USBC office within **31** days of the date bowled. \*

**\* NOTE: If the submitted total points qualify you for BOTH the regular division and/or senior category (age 55 no later than Aug 1<sup>st</sup> of the selection year), the highest point total under the criteria earned will take precedence.**
