



SAN DIEGO USBC BOWLING ASSOCIATION
Youth Male and Female
2010/2011 All Star Team Requirements

A) Eligibility Requirements:

1. Be a member in good standing of the SD/USBC.
2. Purchase your original certified card through the SD/USBC.
3. Only events certified, sponsored or conducted by the SD/USBC will be eligible for points.
4. Selections will be made on the basis of overall performance, sportsmanship and character.
5. Must file an All-Star application by delivering to the association office or postmarked no later than October 31, 2010 to be eligible for the current season.
 - League name and bowling center must be designated clearly in the application.
 - The bowler is responsible to verify All-Star application is on file at association office.
 - May also be given to an SDUSBC Board Member.
6. Must select one sanctioned league under SD/USBC jurisdiction in the current bowling year starting September 1, 2010 through May 30, 2011.
7. Must have a minimum average of; Male: 175, and Female: 155, from the current book.
8. Must have bowled 60 or more games in each league designated on the application.

B) Method of turning in scores:

1. The All-Star committee will compile all applicants' scores for bowling year September 1, 2010 thru May 30, 2011. The Committee will accept the following:
 - The applicant shall submit original's or copies of every recap sheet containing highlighted eligible scores from the designated league on application. It is requested that scores be turned in on a monthly basis.
 - League Secretary.com print-outs, scores highlighted, to be turned in by bowler.
 - Bowling center computer print-outs of designated league, scores highlighted, to be turned in by bowler.
 - Only honor scores will be eligible for All-Star points from non-designated leagues or certified tournament play and is the bowler's responsibility to submit this information via original/copy of recap sheet to the association office by May 30, 2011.
 - **No faxed documents will be acceptable.**
 - Any 298-299-300 game or 700 series (600 Female) and 11 in a row, bowled in summer leagues conducted, sponsored, or certified through the SD/USBC will be credited the following year.

C. Criteria for accumulating All-Star points:

1. League average of designated league on application.
2. Only first three (3) game series shall count regardless of the total number of games bowled in a league or certified tournament.
 - a. Honor scores for additional games will be recognized.
3. Scores from singles leagues do not qualify. (Sport League Averages will NOT be rerated for All Star Points.)
4. Grade Point Average will be compiled from first (1st) semester report card. Original/copy will be accepted and must be turned in by May 30, 2011.

D. Method of accumulating points:

1. League Average - 1 point per pin

Note: Averages from summer leagues are not eligible. (Honor scores will be accepted)

5. Point Structure

a. Tournaments

Youth City Tournament (All Divisions), Banner Scholarship Tournament, and Banner Tournaments

First Place	15 Points
Runner up	11 Points
Third Place	8 Points
Fourth Place	7 Points
Fifth Place	6 Points
Banner Monthly Tournament	5 Points per Team Winner

Note: Scores from tournaments (Other than Honor Scores) will not be considered for points.
