

SAN DIEGO USBC BOWLING ASSOCIATION Youth Male and Female 2024/2025 All Star Team Requirements

A) Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. Be a member in good standing of the SDUSBC.
- 2. Purchase your original certified card through the SDUSBC.
- 3. Only events certified, sponsored or conducted by the SDUSBC will be eligible for points.
- 4. Selections will be made on the basis of overall performance, sportsmanship and character.
- 5. Must file an All-Star application by delivering to the association office or postmarked no later than November 15, 2024 to be eligible for the current season.
 - League name and bowling center must be designated clearly in the application.
 - The bowler is responsible to verify All-Star application is on file at association office.
 - May also be given to an SDUSBC Board Member.
- 6. Must select one sanctioned league under SDUSBC jurisdiction in the current bowling year starting September 1, 2024 through May 15, 2025 or the end of winter league.
- 7. Must have a minimum average of; Male: 175, and Female: 155, from the current book.
- 8. Must have bowled 30 or more games in each league designated on the application.

B) Method of turning in scores:

- 1. The All-Star committee will compile all applicants' scores for bowling year September 1, 2024 thru May 15, 2025 The Committee will accept the following:

 - League Secretary.com print-outs, scores highlighted, to be turned in by bowler.
 - Bowling center computer print-outs of designated league, scores highlighted, to be turned in by bowler.

C. Criteria for accumulating All-Star points:

- 1. League average of designated league on application.
- 2. Only first three (3) game series shall count regardless of the total number of games bowled in a league or certified tournament.
- 3. Scores from singles leagues do not qualify. Sport league scores will not be adjusted.
- 4. Bowlers with centers doing renovations will receive an adjustment for the missing weeks their leagues were unable to bowl due to renovations.

D. Method of accumulating points:

1. League Average - 1 point per pin Note: Averages from summer leagues are not eligible.
