YOUTH CITY TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1 Eligibility:**
 - A) Current Sanctioned Members of the SDUSBC Bowling Association are eligible to participate in this tournament. Membership cards shall be shown upon request. No cards will be sold on site.
 - B) Teams shall consist of four (4) bowlers, any combination.
- 2 Entering average: San Diego USBC averages shall be used;**
 - A) Highest average as of December 31, 2019, 12 gms or more, league sheet required, if none.
 - B) 2018-2019 Winter Book Average, if none
 - C) Average shall be assigned by committee.
 - D) Average from Sport conditions shall be adjusted.
- 3 Format:** All Bowlers will bowl a total of 3 games;
- 4 Divisions:**
 - A) Handicap shall be based on 90% of 220 average.
 - B) **Team; Shall be 2 divisions; Division 1 team average 599 & under, Division 2 team average 600 & over.**
- 5 AWARDS:**
 - A) **Scholarships thru the SMART PROGRAM shall be awarded to every entrant.**
 - B) **SDUSBC shall add "unused" funds from the USBC Smart Account for Girls & Boys Hi Game & Series, Handicap & Scratch. (8 total)**
- 6 General Rules:**
 - A) 10 minutes of shadow practice prior to the start of competition
 - B) Tardy Bowlers may enter the game at any time and shall receive a zero for each fame missed.
 - C) Absentee score shall be minus ten (10) pins from entering average.
 - D) Absolutely no UNSOLICITED coaching will be allowed during the tournament by either Coaches or Parents. No one other than Tournament Officials and score monitors permitted in the bowlers area.
 - E) Collared shirt or Youth Jerseys provided by the centers shall be the dress code, and worn with casual slacks, trousers, or jeans (without holes). Knee length shorts/skorts.
 - F) The following shall be considered INAPPROPRIATE ATTIRE for the Championship Tournament. During participation in any event, Bowlers are NOT permitted to wear; hats, baggy sagging pants, sweats, zupas (pants with elastic cuffs), shall not be permitted. Tournament Manager shall make final decisions.

7	Substitutions:	
	A)	Substitutes shall meet ALL eligibility and average requirements.
	B)	Substitutes shall bowl in the position of the bowler being replaced.
8	<u>CAUSE FOR DISQUALIFICATION:</u>	
	A)	All food and beverages shall be kept on the back counters.
	B)	Playing of any arcade games or any use of any electronic equipment (I-Pods, Cell Phones, etc. NO text messaging) from the first ball of practice until the completion of bowling.
	C)	Display of anger, discontent through the use of vulgar, obscene gestures, foul language, or the abuse of bowling equipment.
	D)	Smoking or drinking alcoholic beverages by participants shall not be permitted during the tournament.
	E)	Any Tournament Official has the right to stop play on a pair of lanes for any infraction of the rules.
		Rule infractions shall be brought to the attention of the Tournament Manager.
	F)	The Tournament Committee shall rule on any rules not covered in these rules.
9	<u>PROTESTS:</u> Shall be made in writing to the Tournament Manager within 72 hours of the infraction. Disputes occurring on the lanes shall be decided by a Tournament Official. (USBC Rule 329 [b] 2.
